The first Annual Blackpool and Fylde Coast Foosball Championship will be held at Walkabout Blackpool on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> September 2009. It is free to enter and teams can consist of 3-5 players. All team members are to be at Walkabout on the 27<sup>th</sup> by 2:30pm for registration and to receive their registration pack. The first games will kick off at 3pm and independent referees will judge all games. The referee's decision is final.

Prizes for the best team uniform will be awarded during the day. Runner-up teams will receive medallions and championship winners will receive the mighty B.A.F.C.A.F.C. trophy along with a team photo and placement in the Walkabout B.A.F.C.A.F.C. hall of fame.

## B.A.F.C.A.F.C. Rules.

- A coin will be flipped to determine who kicks off. ('Bounces' in.)
- A coin will be flipped to determine direction of play.
- No spinning of the rods at any time. (Also known as 360 shots.)
- All games will consist of 9 balls. The first team to five wins the game.
- A match will consist of 3 games and the winner will advance to the next round.
- The final will consist of 5 games.
- Only two team members are allowed to play or touch the table at any given time. Interference by fans or team members on the sideline may result in disqualification.
- If a player is sent off during play a substitute may not resume play until the ball is declared dead.
- The foosball remains in play until it is declared dead, a time out is called, a point is scored or it is hit off the foosball table.
- A ball is declared dead if either team's players cannot reach it.
- Substitutes may only take place while the ball is not in play. A team may make as many substitutes as they wish during a game.
- If the ball is declared dead the last team scored against 'bounces' in.
- If the ball leaves the table the last team scored against will 'bounce' the ball back in at the centre line.
- When a goal is scored the opposing team will 'bounce' in.
- Foosball players or supporters may not manipulate the placement or direction of the ball by rocking the foosball table.
- No swearing, aggressive or abusive behaviour will be tolerated.
- Fun must be had at all times.
